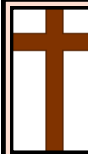
### **POLITE REMINDER REGARDING WHEN THE STAFF CAR PARK MAY BE USED:-**

You are reminded that the above only applies if there is a parking space available. Please do not block anyone in or obstruct access points.

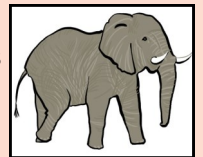
